Motion by Christina Mastrella, seconded by Brian Multerer, install electric for the membership sign and updated bathroom lights, carried unanimously.

New Business:

Landscape quote from – Restorffs was reviewed. Secondary quote from Woodring & Sons will be presented at the April Monthly meeting.

Heating Issues- Trane evaluated the building system and advised that one of the electrical boards have failed. This needed to be replaced quote has been provided in the amount of \$2,875.

Motion by John Kwiatkowski, seconded by Christina Mastrella to have the heating system fixed, carried unanimously.

Recommendation to temporarily adjust Nicole Woodford's hours from 20 per week to 30 per week at the current hourly rate.
